Don Boyd

Don is Co-Director of the State and Local Government Finance Project at Rockefeller College, SUNY Albany, and a consultant, Open Source Policy Center.

Boyd continued work on several projects related to state and local finances in August:

- Analysis of housing insecurity in New York
- Analysis of budgetary spending by the city of San Francisco related to homelessness, for a California foundation
- Examination of revenue options for a large public authority
- Research into emerging risks for state government budgets, for a large operating foundation
- Organizing a project in which economists and analysts will monitor data on migration into and out of New York State and the New York metro area, in the post-Covid era

## Jason DeBacker

Jason is an Associate Professor of economics at the University of South Carolina and a core maintainer of the open source models <u>Cost-of-Capital-Calculator</u>, <u>Tax-Calculator</u>, and <u>OG–USA</u>, which model business taxes and macroeconomic effects of tax policy, respectively.
